

**Peer Review of Teaching** by six separate faculty committees during 1999–2021 all gave their highest rating of “outstanding”. Here are some of their comments: *“His class performance is an admirable example of clarity and efficiency”*; *“Capable of incorporating his wide knowledge into his lectures. His class is interactive and full of animation.”*; *“There seemed to be an easy exchange between students and professor...much material was covered despite the relaxed and unhurried pace of the class.”*; *“His class was lively, full of conceptual examples, witticisms, and a demeanor which encourages participation.”*; *Motivated students to think for themselves – the maieutic method comes alive!*”; *“He engages students with clever observations and stories.
